



# 2011 BULFINCH AWARDS

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

The New England Chapter of the **Institute of Classical Architecture & Art** is pleased to announce its **Second Annual Bulfinch Awards**. Named for Boston's own Charles Bulfinch, America's first native-born architect and the architect of the Massachusetts State House, the awards program will recognize the best work of individuals and firms to preserve and advance the classical tradition in the New England region.

## CATEGORIES

- Residential (Restoration, Renovation, Sympathetic Addition)
- Residential + 5,000 SF (New Construction)
- Residential - 5,000 SF (New Construction)
- Civic/Institutional/Ecclesiastic
- Commercial
- Landscape Architecture
- Artisanry
- Residential Interiors
- Community Design

## ELIGIBILITY

Individuals and firms with addresses within the six (6) New England states: Vermont, New Hampshire, Maine, Massachusetts, Rhode Island, and Connecticut (with the exception of Fairfield County, which falls under the chapter jurisdiction of the New York organization); submitted projects must also be geographically located within the same six states, also with the exception of Fairfield County, Connecticut. Built projects must have been completed within the past five years (July 2006 on).

## **JURY**

There will be a panel jurors consisting of nationally recognized professionals and academics within the Neoclassical tradition.

## **WINNERS**

The winners of the Bulfinch Awards will be recognized at an evening reception at the Massachusetts State House in Boston, November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2011. The winners are expected to attend or send a representative to accept their award.

## **DORIC HALL EXHIBIT**

A week-long public exhibit of submitted projects will be held in the Doric Hall of the Massachusetts State House the week of November 28<sup>th</sup>. Particulars of the exhibit formats will be sent in early October. The entrants shall be responsible for providing and formatting their material (photographs, drawings, models, etc.) for the exhibit.

## **SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

All entries must be submitted in Word and PDF format and sent to Adam Bonosky, at [abonosky@classicist-ne.org](mailto:abonosky@classicist-ne.org) no later than 4 July 2011. All submittal-related questions should be directed to Adam Bonosky.

### **Required submissions:**

- Property/Project Name
- Property/Project Location
- Date of completion
- Square footage (if applicable)
- Publisher (if applicable)
- Agency (if applicable)
- Firm/Individual submitting project
- Brief narrative (no more than 500 words) summarizing the principal aspects of the submitted project to convey its significance to the Awards Jury
- For built projects, photographs (in PDF format) along with scaled and captioned plan(s), elevation(s) and detail(s) and/or sections drawing(s) (all in PDF format) required to properly communicate the design
- File sizes should be no larger than 10 MB (more than one file may be submitted)
