



The 2012 Phillip Trammell Shutze Awards **Submission Requirements & Information**

Program Criteria

The Southeast Chapter is pleased to announce our 6th Annual Shutze Awards Design Competition to recognize excellence in classical and traditional design. The Awards are named for Philip Trammell Shutze, the Atlanta architect whose work is revered internationally as one of the 20th-century's most devoted classicists. The awards will recognize similar individuals who are contributing to the creation of 21st-century Classical and Traditional architecture and related fields.

The awards will be considered for small and large-scale:

- Residential
 - Residential – small single family- under 4,000 sq. ft.
 - Residential –single family- 4,000 - 10,000 sq. ft.
 - Residential – single family - over 10,000 sq. ft.
 - Residential – multifamily (unlimited size)
- Commercial, Civic , Institutional Projects
 - Commercial/ civic / institutional - small - under 10,000 sq. ft.
 - Commercial/ civic / institutional - large- over 10,000 sq. ft.
 - Commercial interior design
- Interior Design
 - Residential Interior Design
 - Commercial Interior Design
- Craftsmanship (iron work, masonry, decorative painting, woodwork etc.)
- Renovation
- Landscape / Garden Design.

The awards jury includes:

- Jury Chair, Anne Fairfax of Fairfax & Sammons Architects
- Juror, David Jones of David Jones Architects
- Juror, Michael Lykoudis, Dean of the School of Architecture at the University of Notre Dame.

Eligibility

Members of the ICAA, Southeast Chapter with offices in the states of Alabama, Mississippi or Georgia are eligible for consideration. The projects may be from any location. The individual or firm making the submission must have the legal right to submit the work of the architects and designers, and must be members of the ICAA. One may join the ICAA at the time of submission online at: www.classicist-se.org or by Contacting Danielle Griffin, Southeast Chapter Coordinator at icasoutheast@gmail.com or 678-447-3996. Since we are seeking current work, the submission must have been created within the last 10 years. The most recent projects that will be considered must be substantially complete as of submission date on **November 28, 2011**.

Winners:

Winners of the 2012 Shutze Awards will be recognized at an evening ceremony held on **February 11, 2012** at the prestigious Piedmont Driving Club, one of Philip Shutze's most significant designs. The winners are expected to attend or send a representative. The winning entries will be displayed on the Southeast ICAA website and published in *Atlanta Homes and Lifestyles* magazine

Submission Requirements:

Each entry should be submitted in a 3-ring binder with end pockets. Nothing should be added to the binder that identifies the firm or individual making the submission. The \$100 submission fee should be paid on line at <https://www.123signup.com/register?id=czjnk>.

The binder should include:

- The entry form should be enclosed in an unsealed envelope and inserted in the front binder pocket
- The entry form A brief statement summarizing significant features of the project, site, landscape, and any details necessary to convey the significance of the project to the jury.
- Photographs of significant views along with plans, sections, details and brief captions sufficient to explain the project to the jury. Similar explanatory information and images should be provided for Interior Design and Craftsmanship submittals.
- CD of electronic images at high resolution of a minimum 300 dpi at 8.5" x 11" page size for publication purposes.
- A prepaid return envelope so the materials may be returned.

Submission Deadline:

The binder and fee must be submitted by **November 28, 2011**. The binder should be submitted to the following address:

Also include a CD of electronic images at high resolution of 300 dpi at 8.5 x 11 with each entry for publication purposes.
