

COVID-19 Guidelines for In-Person 2022 Programming

In line with CDC guidelines, the ICAA intends to hold the 2022 Christopher H. Browne Drawing Tours in person. The ICAA's utmost goal is to provide a safe and academically enriching environment for our students to learn about the history and current practice of classical architecture and design, and will be adopting the following COVID-19 safety guidelines for our 2022 programming. Please carefully review the following guidelines.

- 1. Every participant, instructor and teaching assistant in the 2022 Christopher H. Browne Drawing Tours must provide proof of vaccination prior to joining the in-person program by submitting a scan of the front and back of their CDC COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card. The Vaccination Record Card must show that they have received a booster shot, provided that it has been at least six months since their second dose of the vaccine (or at least two months for those who received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine).
- 2. All participants, instructors, and teaching assistants must receive a COVID-19 test prior to the first day they join the program (either a PCR test within three days of the start of the program or a rapid antigen test within three hours of the program).
- 3. All participants must agree to follow current and evolving CDC COVID-19 safety guidelines, and agree to exercise appropriate caution for the duration of the program, including personal time outside of instructional hours.
- 4. Efforts will be made to provide as much outdoor instruction as possible, and students will be required to mask and physically distance while indoors.
- 5. When in indoor spaces, the ICAA will open windows whenever possible.
- 6. Students will be asked to assist in daily cleaning protocols and personal hygiene practices, including wiping down their individual work stations, handwashing upon entry to program spaces, and wiping down any communal high touch surfaces after their own use.

By attending this program, you acknowledge that you have read and agree to follow the above listed safety protocols, and understand that they may be subject to additions or changes as federal and state safety recommendations evolve.

Note: All information pertaining to the COVID-19 vaccination will be kept completely confidential to the ICAA, and will not be shared with anyone outside the organization or other participants in the Drawing Tour.
