



## **COVID-19 Guidelines for In-Person 2022 Programming**

In line with CDC guidelines, the ICAA intends to hold the course Architectural Rendering in Wash in March 2022. The ICAA's utmost goal is to provide a safe and academically enriching environment for our students to learn about the history and current practice of classical architecture and design, and will be adopting the following COVID-19 safety guidelines for this course. Please carefully review the following guidelines.

1. Every participant, instructor, and teaching assistant for Architectural Rendering in Wash must provide proof of vaccination prior to joining the in-person program by submitting a scan of the front and back of their CDC COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card. The Vaccination Record Card must show that they have received a booster shot, provided that it has been at least six months since their second dose of the vaccine (or at least two months for those who received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine).
2. All participants, instructors, and teaching assistants must receive a COVID-19 test prior to the first day they join the program (either a PCR test within 24 hours of the start of the program or a rapid antigen test within three hours of the program), as well as a rapid antigen test on the second and third days of the program before entering the ICAA's offices. At-home COVID-19 rapid antigen self-test kits are acceptable for this requirement.
3. All participants must agree to follow current and evolving CDC and New York State COVID-19 safety guidelines, and agree to exercise appropriate caution for the duration of the program, including personal time outside of instructional hours.
4. Efforts will be made to provide as much outdoor instruction as possible, and students will be required to mask while indoors and physically distance, in accordance with CDC and New York State guidelines.
5. When in indoor spaces, including the classroom, library, and/or Cast Hall, spaces will be ventilated, by utilizing air purifiers and open windows whenever possible.
6. Students will be asked to assist in daily cleaning protocols and personal hygiene practices, including wiping down their individual work stations, handwashing upon entry to the ICAA's office spaces, and wiping down any communal high touch surfaces after their own use.

By attending this program, you acknowledge that you have read and agree to follow the above listed safety protocols, and understand that they may be subject to additions or changes as federal and state safety recommendations evolve.

Note: All information pertaining to the COVID-19 vaccination will be kept completely confidential to the ICAA, and will not be shared with anyone outside the organization or other participants in the Intensive.
