- Sketchbook; hardbound (+/-) 8" x 10", stitched binding so the book can open flat (Strongly recommended; Moleskine Art Collection Sketchbook A4 size, 8.25" x 11.75")
- 12" triangular architects scale, with 1/8", 1/4", 3/4", 1 1/2" and 3" scales
- Mechanical pencil
- Wooden drawing pencils, 2H, H and HB leads (Recommended: Tombow Mono or Faber Castell 9000 series)
- Pencil Sharpener (Recommended: Blackwing Longpoint or similar)
- Eraser
 - (Recommended: Tuff Stuff Eraser Stick/Factis BM2 or Alvin Vinyl Eraser or similar)
- 12ft or 25ft steel tape measure, to the 1/16"
- Folding artist stool
- Drawing inks: black and sepia
- Steel-nibbed dip pen / mapping pen
- Watercolour supplies to be announced

Optional

- Laser measure (Recommended: Bosch Laser Measurer)
- 50' tape measure
- Small pencil bag or case to keep drawing supplies
- Folding wooden tape measure, 6ft (Recommended: Lufkin x46 with 6' metal slide rule extension)
