#### **ICAA LECTURES WITH BARRY BERGDOLL**

The ICAA has been honored to host a selection of lectures presented by Barry Bergdoll, who is a specialist in late 18th and 19th century French and German architecture, and the author of numerous works on the period, including the textbook European Architecture 1750-1890 in the Oxford History of Art series. He is Professor of Art History at Columbia University and former Chief Curator of Architecture and Design at the Museum of Modern Art.

The following lectures, which focus on classicism and art in France, are presented as part of The Françoise and Andrew Skurman Lecture Series on Classical French Architecture.

# Jean-Jacques Lequeu: The Architectural Imagination in the Age of Reason




On April 14, 2020, the ICAA held its first virtual livestream Public Program by

hosting Barry Bergdoll, who spoke about the vivid imagination and skillful renderings of draftsman and architect Jean-Jacques Lequeu.

Lequeu completed a number of architectural commissions, but he is perhaps most remembered for his fantastic unbuilt conceptions, which he brought to life in beautiful illustrations. In this lecture, Barry Bergdoll explores Lequeu's legacy, and places him in the context of his time.

Architecture in a Time of Upheaval: Projecting the Future in the French Revolutionary Decade 1789-1799



It is often assumed that periods of political upheaval are unproductive in the arts of building. But in fact, the French Revolutionary decade was one of the most vital for new forms of architecture, new definitions of the meanings of architectural form-classical and otherwise--but also the shape of the city and of its citizens. This lecture considers the rethinking of territory, measurement, collective identity, and political organization that accompanied the French Revolution as well as novel new building types and types of urban dwelling.

On Thursday, June 11th, the ICAA hosted Barry Bergdoll, Professor of Art History at Columbia University and former Chief Curator of Architecture and Design at the Museum of Modern Art, for an online lecture on the French Revolutionary Decade, 1789-1799.

Percier and Fontaine were not only the Emperor's official government architects, but two of the most celebrated teachers at the legendary Ecole des Beaux-Arts, responsible for developing the highly influential neoclassical Empire, or Directoire, style of design. 


