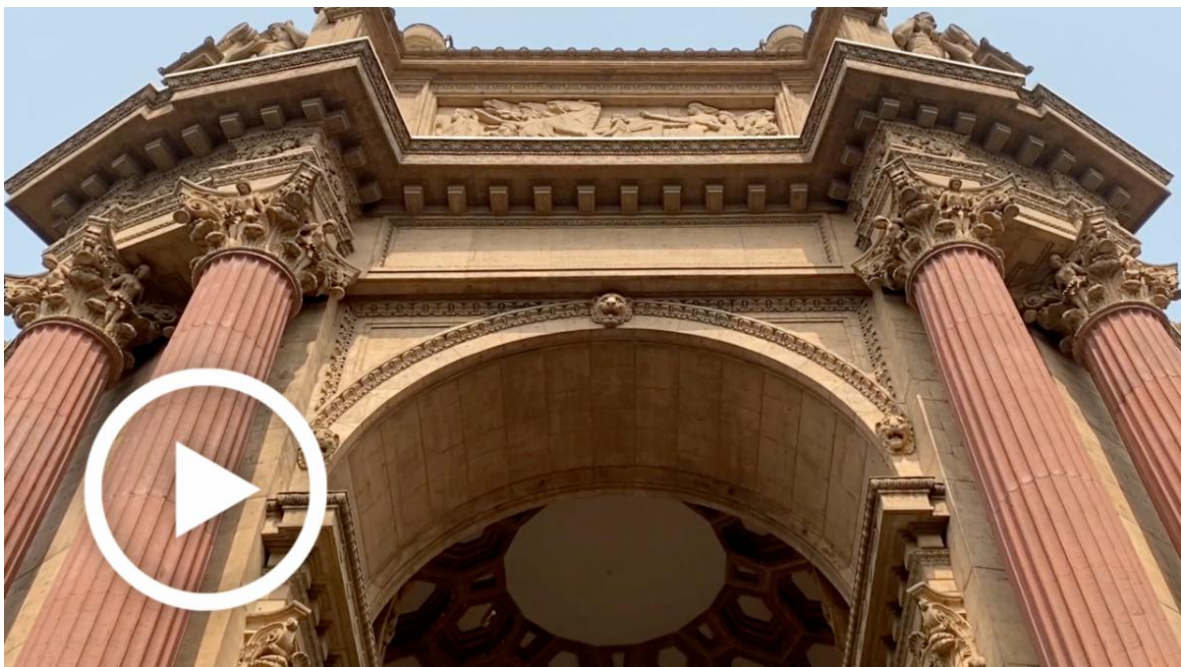

In Your Neighborhood: San Francisco's Palace of Fine Arts *with Suzanne Tucker*



Join AD100 designer Suzanne Tucker, co-founder of [Tucker & Marks](#), for a tour of the Palace of Fine Arts in San Francisco, CA.

In the heart of San Francisco's Marina District lies a Beaux-Arts architectural treasure: the Palace of Fine Arts. California architect Bernard Maybeck originally developed the Palace as a temporary structure for the 1915 Panama-Pacific Exposition, and even intended for the monument to decay into a romantic ruin. Instead, the citizens of San Francisco banded together to preserve the building, and the Palace remains as one of San Francisco's enduring icons to this day.

Join designer Suzanne Tucker on a tour of the Palace and its reflecting pool, and discover the rich history of early twentieth-century San Francisco that produced this enduring monument to the city's spirit.

Shanghai's The Bund: The Perfect Setting to Admire Classical Architecture in the Far East *by Quan (Jerome) Zhai*



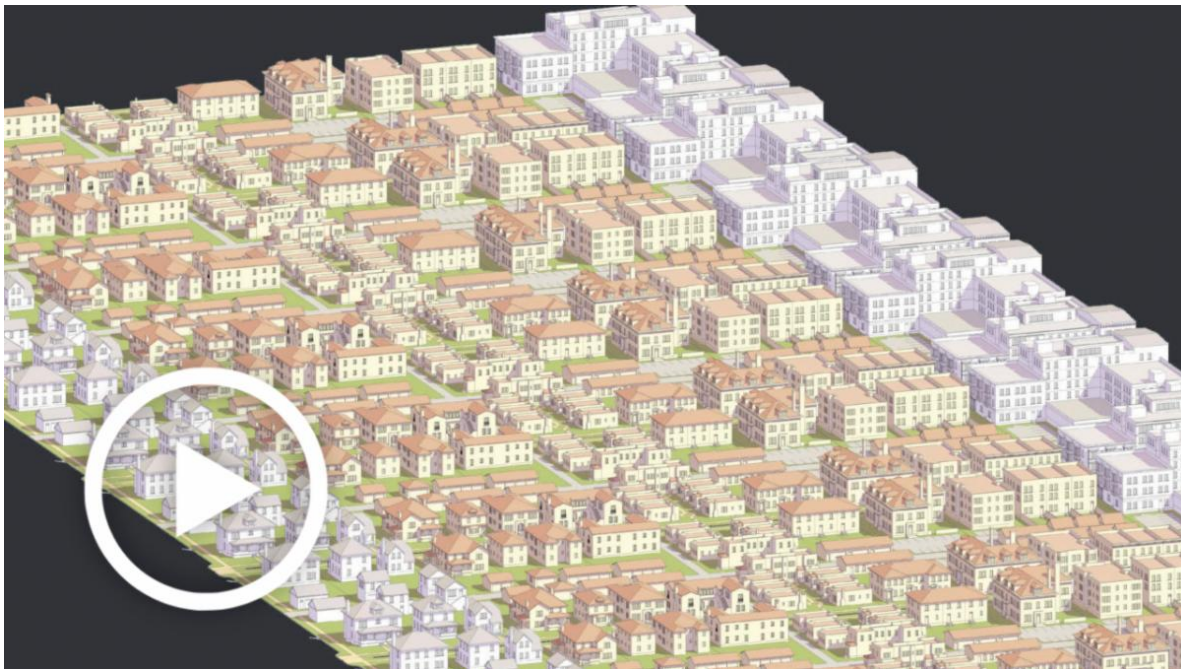

It is difficult to find a country in the world not currently facing a housing crisis. The scale, scope, and nature of the challenge varies from place to place. There is, however, one fundamental reality across the globe: we need to provide more homes; and we need to find the ways to do this that benefit communities without harming the environment.

This talk outlines the concept of 'missing middle housing' and how traditional methods of design can create better places to live, for everyone.

Health and Urbanisation: What is a Healthy City?
with Shipra Narang Suri and David Howard



The second event in the 'Architecture of Place' series was held on October 26, 2020, and featured a lecture from Dr. Shipra Narang Suri and Dr. David Howard.

Our urban areas are expected to grow one and a half times by 2045, to over six billion city dwellers - with developed land projected to triple. This rapid growth and urbanization is also set against the backdrop of natural resource depletion and climate change. In order to plan sustainable cities and communities within this context it is important to take an interdisciplinary approach – understanding that the way in which we design and build our cities impacts our public health, economy, environment, and our mental and physical wellbeing. This talk explores the intersection between health and urbanisation, and what it means for how we plan and manage our cities. David Howard presents his research in urban design and health infrastructure, and Shipra Narang Suri presents on planning services and the role they play in creating healthy living environments. Their presentations are followed by a moderated panel discussion.

Innovation in Technology: The New Reality of
Architecture, Technology, and Construction
*with Shaun Frazier, Lindsey A. DuBosar, Adam
Lowenthal, and Colin Slaten*



On November 10th, 2020, the ICAA hosted a panel of industry experts on how the integration of technology in architecture, design and construction is changing traditional workflow. The panel discussion featured Reis Contracting's Chief Technology Officer Shaun Frazier, Colin Slaten of Peter Pennoyer Architects, Adam Lowenthal of Robert A.M. Stern Architects and Lindsey DuBosar of Hart Howerton.

Terms such as Building Information Modeling and Integrated Project Delivery have been around for years. Despite their advantages, we often find ourselves working in isolation with linear workflows in communication throughout design and construction.

This is in part due to legacy workflows, contractual liabilities, intellectual property practices, awareness of the alternatives, or simply the challenge of technological implementation.

Whether using CAD, ArchiCAD or Revit, the opportunity is ever more present to take full advantage of the “I” in Building Information Modeling and foster a more integrated and efficient partnership between architects, consultants and builders. Cloud based modeling software with point cloud technology, virtual coordination review and clash resolution are especially useful as COVID mandates continue for remote working and onsite distancing.

This panel of technologists, based in classical architecture and construction for high-end residential design, gathered to discuss design coordination and collaboration tools that can be utilized to better leverage a more efficient communication workflow and collaboration.

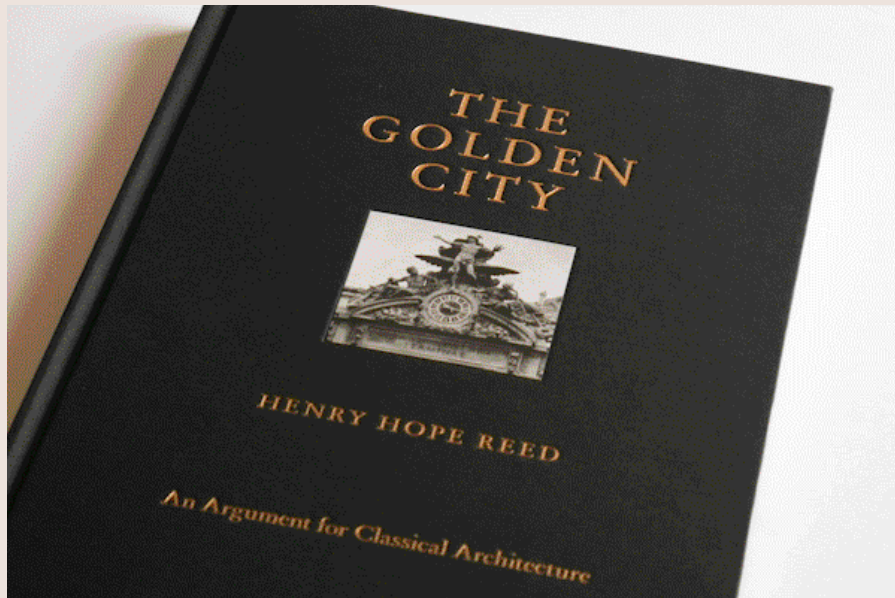
