Andrea Feldman Falcione is the founder of Andrea Feldman Falcione Art Advisory & Consulting. She began her career at the Museum of Modern Art, New York, in the Department of Prints and Illustrated Books as a cataloguer than curator. In 1997, she moved to Los Angeles to join the Broad Art Foundation, where she helped build the collection now on view at The Broad. Three years later, she became curator of the Michael Ovitz Family Collection, and in 2007, she established her own firm, working with a select group of internationally based art collectors and travelers. Feldman Falcione was also the VIP Program Director for the Getty Museum initiatives, *Pacific Standard Time: Art in L.A. 1945–1980* in 2011 and *Pacific Standard Time: Los Angeles/Latin America* in 2017 and the Gallery Program Director for *Pacific Standard Time: Art & Science Collide in 2024*. Feldman Falcione also organizes and leads bespoke art tours for clients including the Cincinnati Art Museum, the Hammer Museum, SFMOMA, the Orange County Museum of Art and the Sun Valley Museum of Art among others.

ACCOMMODATIONS

FOUR SEASONS HOTEL PRAGUE

The spa has five treatment rooms, a vitality pool, a steam room and a sauna.



Itinerary



DAY 1, OCT. 2: WELCOME TO PRAGUE

- Upon arrival, transfer to the Four Seasons Hotel Prague for check-in and time to refresh. *Check-in begins at 3:00 p.m.*
- *Optional:* In the early evening, embark on an introductory walking tour of the Old Town, taking time to see the historic Astronomical Clock, a celebrated landmark known for its intricate design and centuries-old mechanical display.
- Tonight, enjoy a special welcome dinner.

OVERNIGHT: FOUR SEASONS HOTEL PRAGUE | MEALS: D

DAY 2, OCT. 3: DISCOVERING PRAGUE

- Start the morning with a visit to Strahov Monastery Library—renowned for its magnificent Baroque halls, frescoed ceilings and centuries-old collections of rare manuscripts and books—and access parts of the library normally closed to the public. From here, walk to Prague Castle, with a stop at Sternberg Palace’s hidden sculpture garden along the way.
- Exclusive tour of Prague’s most iconic Gothic landmark: St. Vitus Cathedral. You will have access to St. Wenceslas Chapel and the Royal Crypt.
- Lunch will take place at Lobkowitz Palace, a magnificent Baroque residence filled with art, historical treasures and a celebrated music collection. Enjoy a private tour of the family’s collection with the 1st prince of Lobkowitz, William E. Lobkowitz.
- In the late afternoon, walk back to the hotel through the 17th-century Waldstein Garden, returning around 5:00 p.m. for the evening and dinner at leisure.
- *Optional, at an additional cost:* Tonight, you may wish to attend an opera or concert at one of the historical theaters such as Rudolfinum, National Opera or Estates Theatre.

DAY 3, OCT. 4: SOUTHERN BOHEMIA COUNTRYSIDE

- Depart early this morning for a 2.5-hour drive to Český Krumlov, a city in the South Bohemia region of the Czech Republic. Here you will have a private visit to UNESCO World Heritage site Český Krumlov Castle, with exclusive access to the Bellaria Summer House, the Castle Library and Gardens and a special behind-the-scenes exploration of the Baroque Theatre—widely considered one of the best-preserved Baroque theaters in Europe.
- Lunch at a local restaurant and time to explore, before driving 45 minutes to the small town of Hluboká nad Vltavou for a private visit to its spectacular Hluboká Castle. This Neo-Gothic residence is renowned for its ornate interiors and landscaped gardens.
- Enjoy light snacks and refreshments before driving back to Prague (2-hour drive).
- The rest of the evening and dinner is at leisure.

DAY 4, OCT. 5: WALKING TOUR OF PRAGUE

- This morning, divide into groups for your full-day walking tour of Prague's historical center, Malá Strana. See Charles Bridge—the city's most iconic medieval crossing—hidden courtyards (including hidden gem Vrtba Garden) and Prague's Baroque masterpiece, St. Nicholas Church.
- Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant with Karen Feldman, the American designer living in Prague who owns ARTÊL, a globally-known producer of handcrafted bespoke crystal pieces. You will visit the studio and have a special workshop with Karen.
- Private tour of the Lord Mayor's Residence, an Art Deco ceremonial suite designed by František Roith.
- Tonight, enjoy a casual dinner with your host and fellow travelers.

Itinerary

DAY 5, OCT. 6: NORTHERN BOHEMIA COUNTRYSIDE

- Private tour of Château Veltrusy, the Rococo jewel of the Lower Vltava, followed by the 16th-century Nelahozeves Castle, a Renaissance masterpiece of the House of Lobkowitz, where you'll enjoy a curator-led visit highlighting Old Master paintings.
- Opportunity to visit the birth house of Czech composer Antonín Dvořák and have a light lunch near the estate.
- Head to Troja Palace, a remarkable Baroque villa by architect Jean Baptiste Mathey. Owned by the city, the palace holds collections of 19th-century Czech art.
- The rest of the evening and dinner is at leisure.

DAY 6, OCT. 7: DISCOVERING PRAGUE

- Walking tour with a local expert exploring Art Nouveau, Cubist and Brutalist architecture across Prague. You may wish to visit the House at the Black Madonna—Prague's first Cubist building which holds a permanent exhibition on Czech Cubism.
- Private tour of one of the city's Art Nouveau gems, Municipal House, home to the celebrated concert venue Smetana Hall.
- Lunch at Café Imperial, one of the most iconic Art Deco cafés celebrated for its 20th-century elegance, followed by time to pack and refresh before dinner.
- Exclusive after-hours visit and celebratory farewell dinner at the historic Savarin Palace. See the recently opened Mucha Foundation Art Museum with Marcus Mucha, the founder of the museum, who will guide you through the family's iconic posters, drawings and personal items that emphasize their Czech identity and utopian, artistic philosophy.

Complimentary International Global Rescue Services Coverage

To help you travel more safely, responsibly and seamlessly, as part of your signup and registration, **all guests on International Indagare Journeys receive Global Rescue coverage for the dates of their journey as an added benefit.** Global Rescue is not travel or trip insurance, but in the event that an emergency occurs during the trip, guests have access to a variety of services, including medical assistance and evacuation assistance. Indagare also strongly recommend that you purchase additional travel insurance for your trip, in case an unforeseen emergency arises or you need medical treatment while traveling. Global Rescue Overview

Global Rescue was founded in 2004 and has five operations centers and offices in five countries, with 200-plus medical centers of excellence worldwide and 20,000-plus operations globally. Global Rescue operations centers are staffed by experienced nurses, paramedics and military special operations veterans.

For the duration of any Indagare Journey you have access to:

- **24/7 medical assistance and advisory services for natural disasters, terror attacks and civil unrest**
- **Evacuations from the point of injury / illness to home country hospital (pending the type of care and level of care needed)**
- **Travel intelligence services, including alerts and real-time destination reports for 215 countries**

Additional services include: symptom triage, referral to local hospital or clinic, urgent/emergency message relay, telephonic support, health information services, replacement of lost medical supplies & medical triage.

Additional Trip Insurance Recommendation

It is important to note that the **Global Rescue coverage that comes with every purchase of an Indagare Journey is not the same as travel or trip insurance**, which—among other features—offers financial protection concerning situations that occur before a trip begins and require a change or cancellation of travel plans. These can include a personal or family illnesses or other unexpected factors such as lost luggage, flight disruption, illnesses or accidents that require emergency medical treatment and/or hospitalization.

So that guests can plan and undertake travel with the minimum possible financial risks, **Indagare also strongly recommends that guests joining Indagare Journeys trips purchase travel insurance to cover their trip(s).** Travel insurance may be obtained from any of a number of providers that specialize in such insurance, and as a courtesy to guests, **Indagare can arrange for a quote for coverage with our preferred providers to be prepared and emailed directly to you at your request.**

Note: Plans from some providers can be purchased up to 24 hours prior to departure; others require 14 days notice. Indagare recommends opting in to a plan well in advance of your trip. Please be advised that Indagare is not a licensed insurance company or advisor.
