Employing the potter's wheel as her primary tool, she generates and manipulates forms, often drawing inspiration from various natural elements and textures. Her utilitarian ceramic pieces exhibit these influences, utilizing techniques such as sgraffito, glaze application, and textured surface treatments. Even in her non-functional works, she strives to maintain a connection to traditional vessel forms and traditional ceramic processes.
