A Tribute to Female Architects

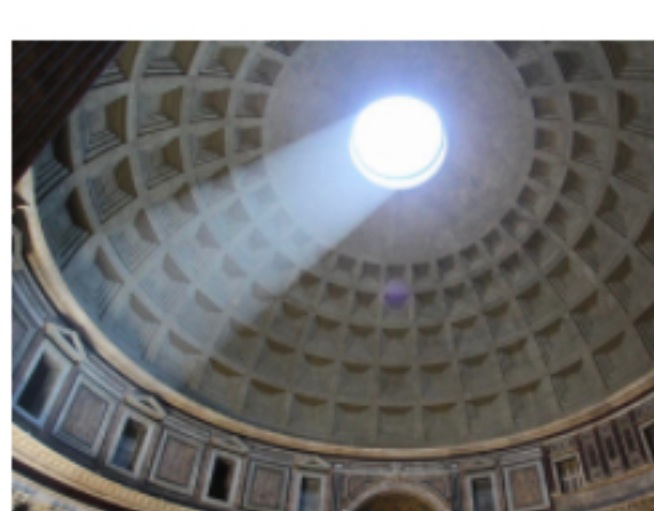

Rome, Italy

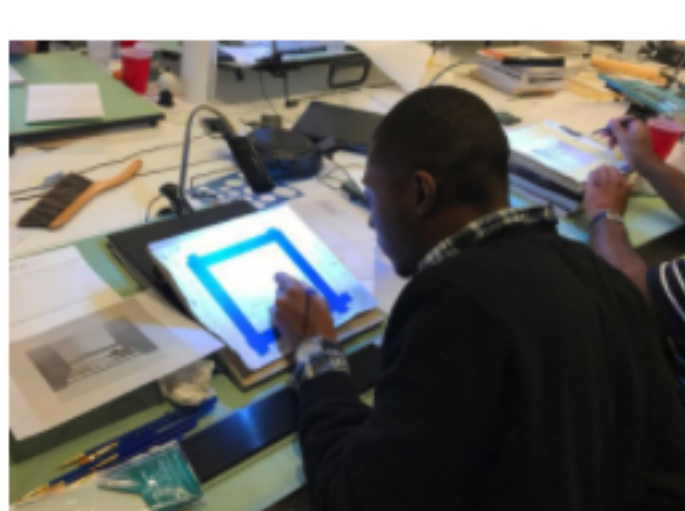

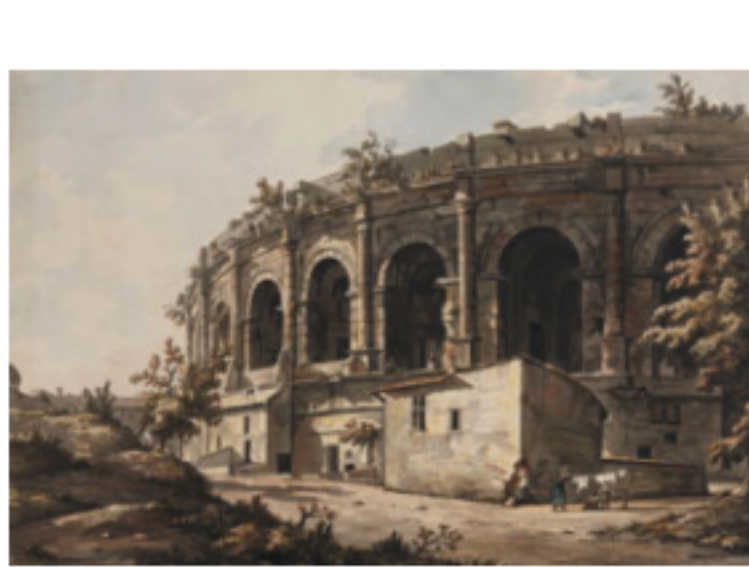

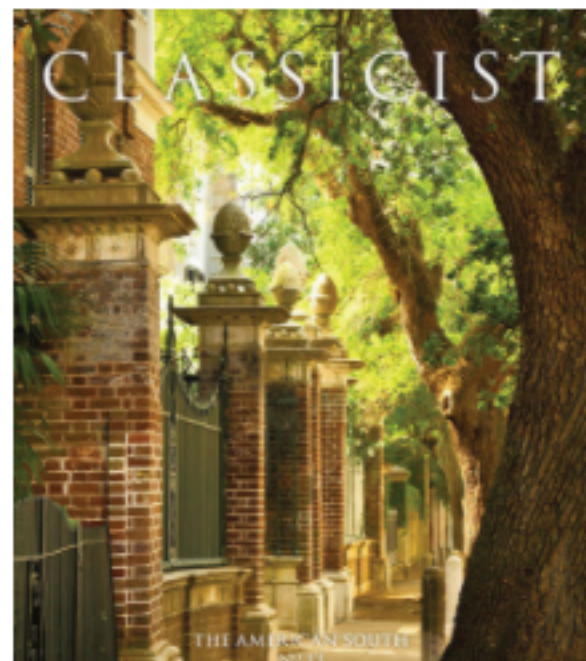
