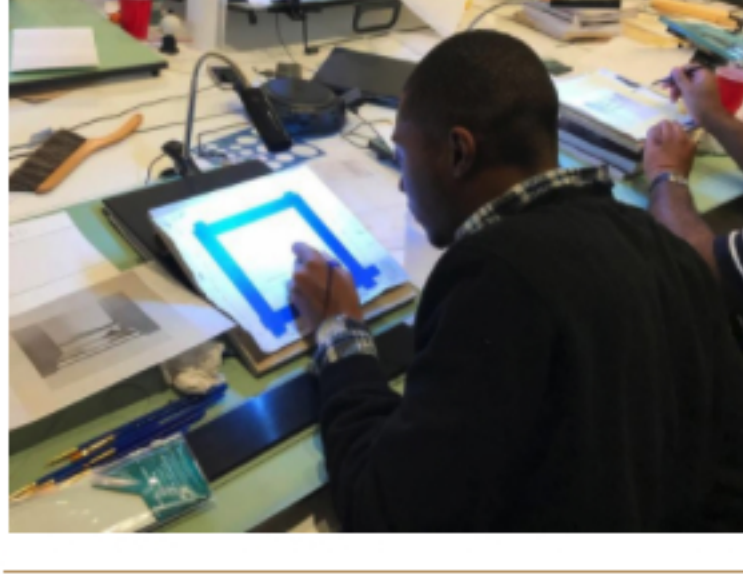

Scholarship Application Deadline Approaching on August 25



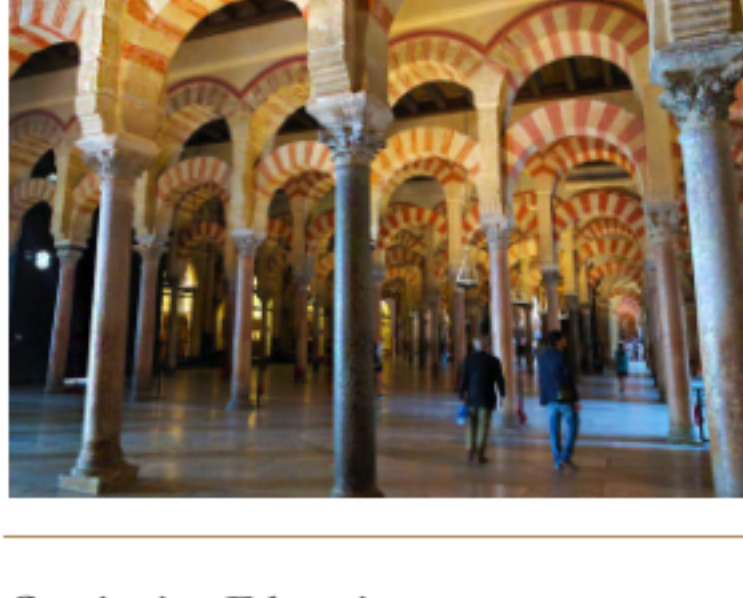
